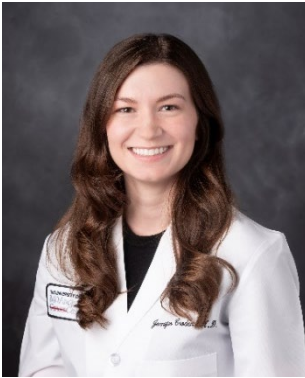

Jennifer Croden, MD is a first-year Fellow in the Leukemia Clinical Fellowship Program at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, joining in July 2024. Dr. Croden plans to pursue a career as an academic hematologist with focus on acute leukemias and the operation and management of clinical trials.

Dr. Croden obtained her Doctor of Medicine from the University of Alberta, Canada, in 2019. Dr. Croden was the recipient of the Moshier Memorial Gold Medal, awarded to the top student in her graduating year.

Prior to joining the Leukemia Fellowship Program, Dr. Croden completed her Internal Medicine residency training at the University of Alberta, during which time she served as chief resident. She then completed a Hematology fellowship at the University of Alberta in June 2024. During her training, she received several clinical and academic awards, including the Journal of Thrombosis and Haemostasis Editors' Award in 2022 and the Dr. Michael Mant Award in 2023 for her hematology research contributions.

In addition, Dr. Croden studied jazz and contemporary music composition and worked as a professional musician prior to pursuing a medical career. She is a multi-instrumentalist, including piano, guitar, and cello.
