Mehmet Sevki Uyanik, MD is a first-year Fellow in the Leukemia Clinical Fellowship Program at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center, joining in July 2024. Dr. Uyanik plans to expand his clinical skills in the treatment of myelodysplastic syndrome and acute myeloblastic leukemia in the post-transplant setting. His long-term goal is to participate in research studies on cellular drug delivery systems using engineered red blood cells.

Dr. Uyanik obtained his medical degree from Uludag University Faculty of Medicine, Turkey, in 2005. During his residency in internal medicine, Dr. Uyanik gave an exceptional presentation at the Salzburg Columbia University Seminars. This presentation was notably showcased on the AAF Open Medical Institute E-Learning Platform's website. Dr. Uyanik completed both his residency training in 2010 and his hematology fellowship program in 2014 at Trakya University Faculty of Medicine. Prior to joining the Department of Leukemia, Dr. Uyanik worked in a bone marrow transplantation center where over 100 bone marrow transplants were conducted between 2019 and 2023 in Turkey. He received the Young Scientist Award from the Turkish Hematology Association twice in 2013 and 2014, during his hematology fellowship program.

Dr. Uyanik has played drums for thirty years in three different local bands and has given concerts for the benefit of children diagnosed with leukemia, medical school students, and the local community. He is fluent in English and Turkish.
