PROGRAM GOALS:

This program is designed to give navigators across Texas the opportunity to come together virtually to increase knowledge and skills when navigating patients in the clinic and at the community setting. The goal is to give navigators -working with patients needing breast, cervical, and colorectal screening exams- the opportunity to share challenges and the experiences encountered during the process of navigating patients.

Through this virtual program, navigators will be able to share experiences, including cases of patients who encountered barriers when seeking care, and patient in-reach and out-reach successes and difficulties. The goal is to work as a team to help resolve and assist with any navigation barriers.
