The Robert A. Wolff Education Endowment



After 20 years as Director of the Division of Cancer Medicine Hematology/Oncology Fellowship Program, **Robert A. Wolff, M.D.**, has shared his decision to step down from this leadership role. He will continue to serve as Professor of Gastrointestinal Medical Oncology and Cancer Medicine Deputy Division Head for Clinical and Educational Affairs. He also will retain his endowed position as Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan Distinguished University Chair of Medical Oncology, and his position as Chair of the Committee for Professional Education and Training for the Sheikh Khalifa Institute for Personalized Cancer Therapy (IPCT).

Since 1999, Dr. Wolff has successfully helmed the fellowship to national prestige. Having educated over 230 graduates from as many as 30 different countries, his global impact on hematology and medical oncology cannot be overstated. Dr. Wolff has not only invested time in the fellowship but has also invested his funds, both institutional and personal. He has sponsored travel for fellows to present at national and international meetings, encouraged and paid for trainees to obtain masters degrees, and sponsored many team building events for the program.

To honor his legacy, we have established the Robert A. Wolff Education Endowment. Our fund raising goal is \$2 million; a principal that would be invested by The University of Texas Investment Management Company, a nonprofit entity supervised by a group of investment professionals. Annual distributions from the earnings would generate approximately \$90,000 per year to support the fellowship program. With your help, we can establish a permanent source of support for this invaluable program, which will give the rising oncology stars of tomorrow a chance to spend time developing their skills and training as hematologists and medical oncologists with renowned MD Anderson faculty.
